Spirometry courses

As well as a one-day refresher course for individuals who require a refresher in all aspects of occupational spirometry measurements and interpretation.



Vision course

A comprehensive one-day course incorporating all theoretical and practical aspects of industrial vision screening programmes.

The course includes vision requirements, screening tests, results analysis, and potential hazards in the workplace.



Audiometry

Purpose-built for occupational health and primary care professionals, our audiometry courses provide delegates with the skills and confidence to deliver high-quality hearing assessments.

Our courses are designed around the British Society of Audiology (BSA) recommended syllabus and aligned with the Health and Safety Executive's Control of Noise at Work Regulations (3rd edition, L108, 2021), together with industry-specific requirements and occupational health specialists.

Two-day competency course

Accredited by the BSA, this two-day competency course equips delegates with the knowledge and hands-on skills to perform screening audiometry and accurately evaluate and categorise subject test results.

One-day refresher course

This one-day audiometry refresher course offers a blend of theory and hands-on practice, ideal for occupational health professionals seeking to refresh their skills and ensure they conduct workplace screening audiometry to the highest standard.

Spirometry

One-and-a-half-day competency course

This comprehensive spirometry course is designed for occupational health professionals with prior experience in spirometry who require a competency-based assessment to perform lung function testing.

The course covers both the theoretical and practical aspects of spirometry, including the interpretation of pulmonary function test results. Participants will complete a written and practical examination based on the content covered on day one.

One-day refresher course
